**This Licence is subject to the following terms, conditions and restrictions:**

- 1 That should the licensee's draw adversely affect the aquifer or other users in the area, the Water and Rivers Commission may reduce the amount that may be drawn.
- 2 Approval by the Water and Rivers Commission is to be obtained prior to the construction of additional and replacement wells and the modification or refurbishment of existing wells.
- 3 The licensee shall install and maintain a cumulative water meter(s) of a type authorised under the Rights in Water and Irrigation (Approved Meters) Order 2003 to all production wells and the meter(s) must be installed in accordance with the meter(s) manufacturers specification by 10 June 2007 or within two months of the bore/s being drilled under CAW162180(1).
- 4 That the licensee shall record the volume of groundwater drawn monthly and forward the information to the Water and Rivers Commission by 28 February each year.
- 5 The licensee shall comply with the operating strategy as prepared by the licensee and approved by the Water and Rivers Commission on 13 March 2007, including any modifications to the strategy as approved during the term of the licence.
- 6 That the licensee shall measure the water rest level every month relative to a specified datum, and forward the information to the Water and Rivers Commission by 28 February each year.
- 7 Annual Production Summary reports are to be submitted to the Water and Rivers Commission for assessment by 28 February each year.

- 1 The well must be constructed by a driller having a current class 1 water well drillers certificate issued by the Western Australian branch of the Australian Drilling Industry Association or other certification approved by the Water and Rivers Commission as equivalent.
- 2 That the depth of the bore/s shall be limited to the superficial aquifer.
- 3 That should the bore/s be abandoned it/they shall be sealed off to the satisfaction of the Water and Rivers Commission.
- 4 The licensee is required to provide to the Water and Rivers Commission a completed 'Particulars of Completed Bore Hole Form' on completion of the approved drilling programme.
