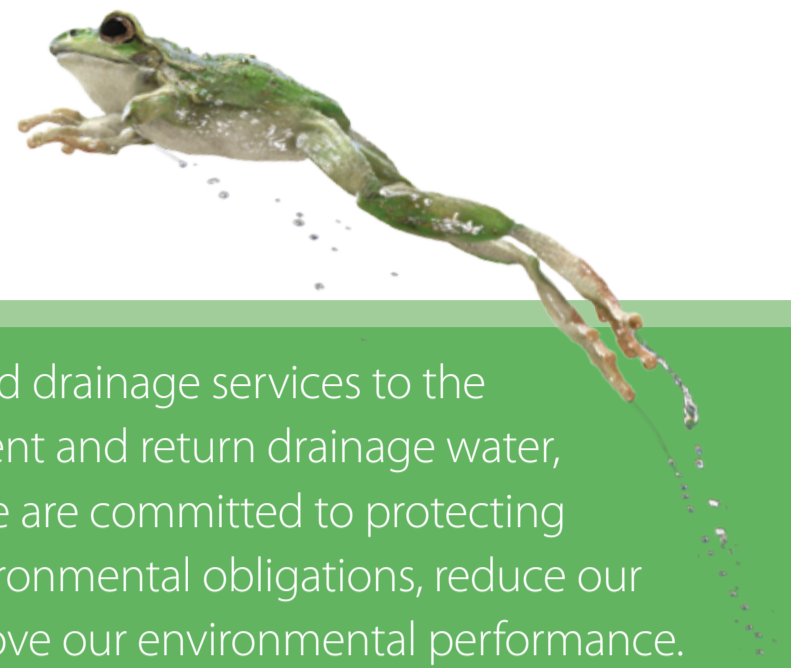


Environment Policy
