1.0	<b>PREVIOUS MINUTES / ACTIONS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Previous minutes endorsed out of session – 21 October 2010.</li> </ul>		
2.0	<b>SITE UPDATE</b> <u>Update by John Stansfield:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two marine tunnels (the first intake tunnel and the outfall diffuser tunnel) are now complete and flooded with water. The diffuser pipe is in place and will be connected to the outfall tunnel next week.</li> <li>• The roof is on the drinking water tank.</li> <li>• JS noted that during November a 1.5km length of small conduit will ran from the site along the primary dunes toward Binningup to test earthing qualities.</li> <li>• Taranto Road is to be sealed by the end of next week.</li> </ul>		
3.0	<b>SIMP REVIEW</b> <u>Jo Ann Beckwith from Beckwith Environmental Planning</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• JB reviewed the draft audit prepared by the Water Corporation and provided feedback.</li> <li>• JB commented that she thought overall the SIMP was going very well.</li> <li>• JB asked for the CRG's input into what they / the community perceived as the biggest impacts:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Marine closure – not huge impact.
