long-term residents

Caravan park owners receive an annual account for water services to their park in July each year. Water use charges are billed throughout the year depending on when the water meter is read.

Annual service charges are generally billed at the non-residential rate, similar to other businesses. However, caravan park owners have the option of declaring some bays as 'long-term residential'. These bays are charged at a reduced rate.

annual service charges

water

The charge for each long-term residential caravan bay for 2011–12 is \$131.10. The other bays are charged at non-residential rates based on the size of the water meter serving the property.

wastewater

The charge for each long-term residential caravan bay for 2011–12 is \$228.00.

The other bays are charged at the non-residential rate, based on the number of major fixtures (urinals and toilets).



charges for use

water

119.2 cents per kilolitre (2011–12 charges). Water use above 150 kilolitres is charged at a higher rate.

wastewater

Caravan parks are charged for the amount of wastewater discharged into the wastewater system. Each caravan park has a standard sewer discharge allowance of 200 kilolitres.

Where long-term residential bays are declared, an additional allowance of 75 kilolitres per residential bay applies. Any sewer discharge in excess of the allowance is charged at 253.8 cents per kilolitre.
