



## Waterwise Garden Assessors

The Waterwise Garden Assessor (WWGA) program was developed in 2007. The program is open to all Waterwise Garden Centre staff, who have completed and passed the Corporation's Waterwise Garden training, and to endorsed Waterwise Landscapers.

During an assessment, trained garden specialists assess how water efficient a garden currently is and make recommendations for the reduction of water use. The key is education – you can be water efficient and still have a nice garden.

Every Garden Assessor endorsed by the Corporation must meet the requirements of the program criteria, including training in the latest waterwise gardening techniques. The training is organised by the Water Corporation and facilitated by a local gardening expert, such as John Colwill or Chris Ferreira.
