The Waterwise Garden Centre (WWGC) program was launched in September 2003 in conjunction with the Nursery and Garden Industry of WA (NGIWA), and Sustainable Gardening Australia (SGA) came on board in 2006.

The objective is to positively influence consumption trends towards more water efficient garden designs, plants, mulches, soil wetting agents and associated products.

Every Garden Centre endorsed by the Corporation must meet the requirements of the WWGC program criteria, including training of staff in the latest Waterwise gardening techniques. The training is organised by the Water Corporation and facilitated by a local gardening expert, such as John Colwill or Chris Ferreira.
