Wetlands and the oceans 'cause lots of things live there

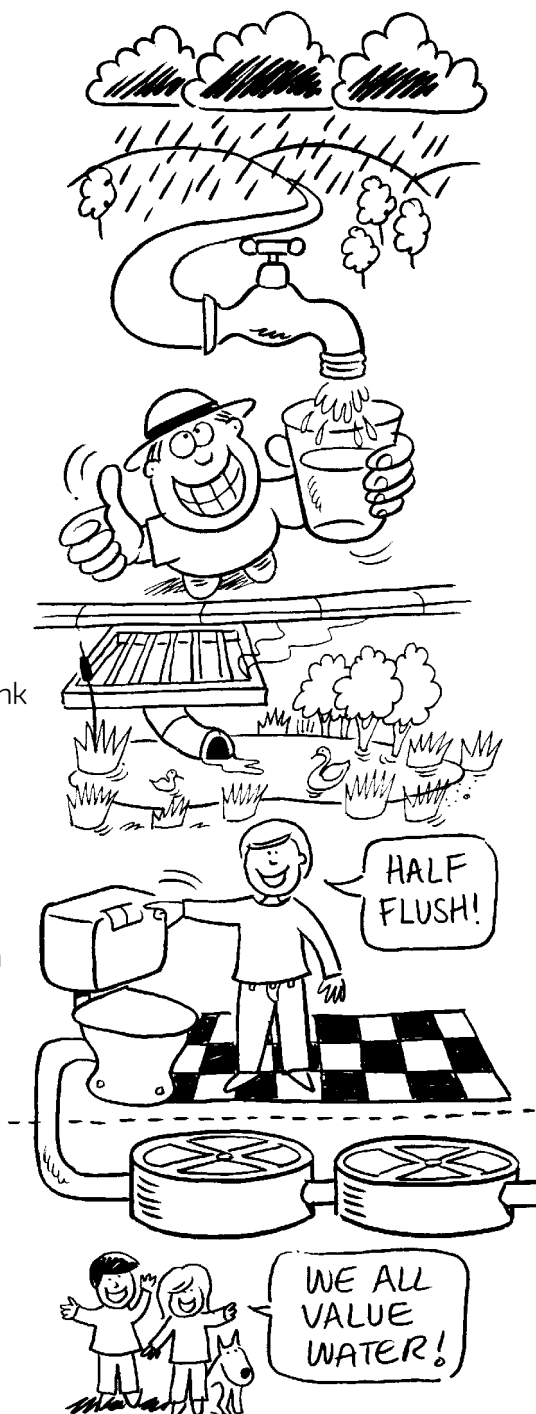
