## Nash Street water main renewal work to start week of 18 February 2019

Since July 2016 Water Corporation's Pipes for Perth program has been proactively replacing ageing water mains across metropolitan Perth, including City of Perth.

Water Corporation will soon start work to replace around **3.2 kilometers** of water mains across Northbridge, Perth, Highgate and Mt Lawley.

This includes **Nash Street** between Mclver Train Station and Aberdeen Street in Perth.

### Where is this happening?

Construction work will start near Mclver Train Station and will progress towards the intersection of Nash Street and Aberdeen Street.

Security fencing and all construction work will take place in the northbound lanes on Nash Street. Both the parking lane and the northbound traffic lane will be closed during construction.

Both Nash Street southbound lanes will temporarily be used to allow traffic to flow in both southbound and northbound directions. Please note there will be no onsite parking during this time. Full traffic management will be in place.

We will endeavour to maintain full access to all residential properties and businesses. We will speak with you directly to make alternative arrangements should we need to restrict any property access.

### When is this happening?

Construction of the new water main will begin the week of **18 February 2019** and is expected to take up to **five weeks** to complete. Work will be carried out Monday to Saturday between 7am and 7pm.

Our authorised contractor, Civcon, will be in the area to locate underground services i.e. telecommunications, gas, electrical etc. prior to construction work starting. This work will require some potholing. Traffic management will be in place, as required.

We recognise this is a busy time in Northbridge and Perth. We have scheduled the work to ensure our construction doesn't impact major events, including Fringe Festival, Chinese New Year and Perth Festival.

### Our process

Renewing water pipes is a complex and detailed process. Some of this work includes locating underground services, laying the new pipe, pressure and water quality testing and most importantly, connecting the new pipe to the water network. While it may not always look like work is happening, rest assured, this is reflective of a standard construction process.

Our contractors use a combination of construction methods, including trenchless and open excavation. Unfortunately, construction work of this nature means unavoidable impact to roads, footpaths and verges. All impacted areas are backfilled and reinstated to City of Perth standards.
