James Street water main renewal work to start week of 15 April 2019

Since July 2016 Water Corporation's Pipes for Perth program has been proactively replacing ageing water mains across metropolitan Perth, including City of Perth.

Water Corporation appointed contractor, Civcon, have started work to replace about **3.2 kilometers** of water mains across Northbridge, Perth, Highgate and Mt Lawley.

This includes **James Street** between Pier Street and Beaufort Street.

Please read this information sheet which includes important information about how this work will impact you.

When is this happening?

Construction of the new water main will begin the week of **15 April 2019** and is expected to take up to **six weeks** to complete. Main works will be carried out Monday to Saturday between 7am and 7pm. Additional work between 7pm and 7am may be required, you will receive prior notification of night work taking place.

Where is this happening?

Construction work on James Street will start at the intersection of Pier Street and will progress west towards Beaufort Street.

Traffic management

Security fencing and all construction work will take place in both the eastbound lanes of James Street. Both the parking lane and the traffic lane will be closed during construction.

Between Stirling Street and Beaufort Street, westbound traffic lanes will remain open and will flow in both directions. There will be a reduction of on street parking. Full traffic management will be in place.

Between Stirling Street and Pier Street, westbound traffic lanes will remain open and will flow only westbound. Eastbound traffic will be restricted during the construction duration. Please note there will be reduced onsite parking during this time. Full traffic management and detours will be in place.

The intersection of Stirling Street and James Street will remain open, with work being carried out to renew this section overnight and at restricted hours during the day.

The intersection of Beaufort Street and James Street will remain open, with work being carried out to renew this section overnight.

Driveway access

We will endeavour to maintain full access to all residential properties and businesses. We will speak with you directly to make alternative arrangements should we need to restrict any property access. If you require immediate access to your property please speak to a crew member on site, or call Civcon Project Engineer **Marcos Miranda** on **0488 438 011**.



Civcon will be in the area to locate underground services i.e. telecommunications, gas, electrical etc. prior to construction work starting. This work will require some potholing. Traffic management will be in place, as required.

Water supply interruptions

Water supply interruptions will be carried out outside of business operating hours. If we are required to restrict your water supply you will be notified 48 hours in advance.

Our process

Renewing water pipes is a complex and detailed process. Some of this work includes locating underground services, laying the new pipe, pressure and water quality testing and most importantly, connecting the new pipe to the water network. While it may not always look like work is happening, rest assured, this is reflective of a standard construction process.

Reinstatement

Our contractors use a combination of construction methods, including trenchless and open excavation. Unfortunately, construction work of this nature means unavoidable impact to roads, footpaths and verges. All impacted areas are backfilled and reinstated to City of Perth standards.

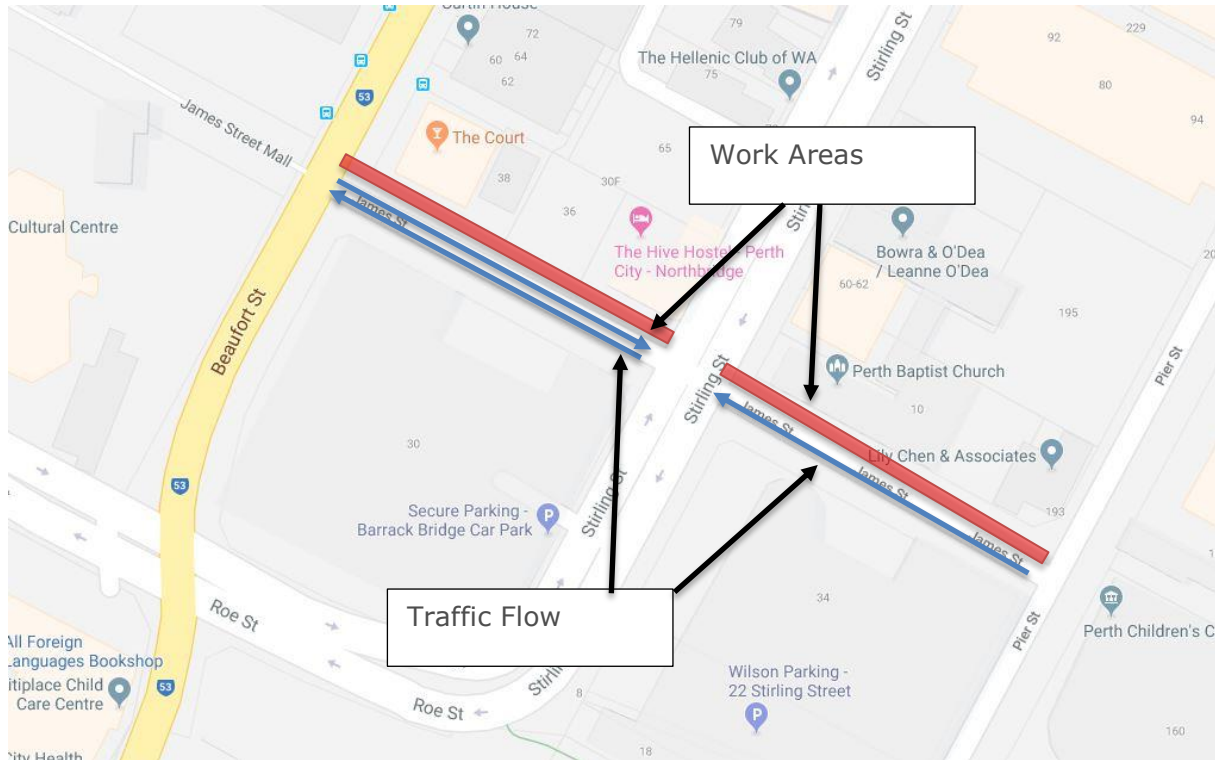
