## Victoria Avenue water main renewal work to start week of 15 April 2019

Since July 2016 Water Corporation's Pipes for Perth program has been proactively replacing ageing water mains across metropolitan Perth, including City of Perth.

Water Corporation appointed contractor, Civcon, are currently replacing around **3.2 kilometers** of water mains across Northbridge, Perth, Highgate and Mt Lawley.

This includes **Victoria Avenue** between Victoria Square and Terrace Road.

Please read this information sheet which includes important information about how this work will impact you.

### Where is this happening?

Construction work on Victoria Avenue will start at the intersection of Victoria Square and will progress south towards Terrace Road.

### When is this happening?

Construction of the new water main will begin the week of **15 April 2019** and is expected to take up to **six weeks** to complete. Work will be carried out Monday to Saturday between 7am and 7pm. Customers will be notified in advance of any work to be undertaken outside of these work times.

Civcon will be in the area to locate underground services prior to construction work starting. This work will require some potholing. Traffic management will be in place, as required.

### Traffic management

Between Victoria Square and Adelaide Terrace both Victoria Avenue southbound lanes will be closed. There will be a reduction of on street parking. Northbound lanes will not be impacted.

Between Adelaide Terrace and Terrace Road, one Victoria Avenue southbound lane will be closed and one Victoria Avenue southbound lane will remain open. There will be a reduction of on street parking. Northbound lanes will not be impacted.

The intersection of Adelaide Terrace and Hay Street will remain open, with work being carried out to renew these sections overnight and at restricted hours during the day.

### Driveway access

We will endeavour to maintain full access to all residential properties and businesses. We will speak with you directly to make alternative arrangements should we need to restrict any property access.

### Water supply interruption

Water supply interruptions will be carried out outside of business operating hours. If we are required to restrict your water supply you will be notified 48 hours in advance.



## Our process

Renewing water pipes is a complex and detailed process. Some of this work includes locating underground services, laying the new pipe, pressure and water quality testing and most importantly, connecting the new pipe to the water network. While it may not always look like work is happening, rest assured, this is reflective of a standard construction process.

## Reinstatement

Our contractors use a combination of construction methods, including trenchless and open excavation. Unfortunately, construction work of this nature means unavoidable impact to roads, footpaths and verges. All impacted areas are backfilled and reinstated to City of Perth standards.

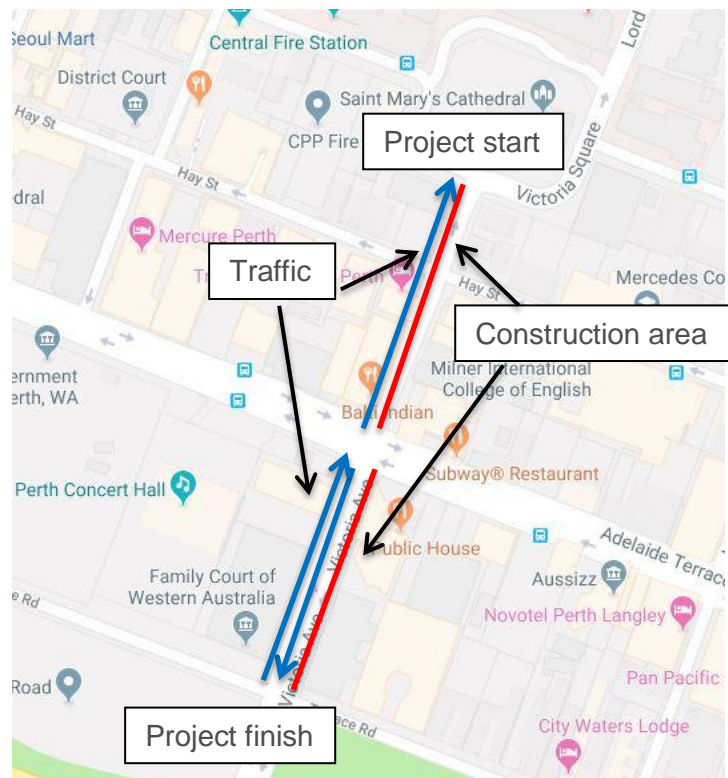
