Water supply bore construction in Sheldrake Reserve

What's happening?

Water Corporation will soon start work to install a new groundwater bore in Sheldrake Reserve, City of Stirling. This bore is part of our long-term plan to provide safe and secure water for the future.

When is this work happening?

We have timed the construction of the bore until after the completion of the cricket season. The bore will be constructed across three stages of work:

Stage	Timeframe	Activity	Expected work hours
Stage 1	March 2019	Site preparation for drilling rig and equipment	7am to 5pm Monday to Friday 7am to 2pm Saturday
Stage 2	Late March 2019 to April 2019	Deep underground drilling	7am to 10pm Monday to Sunday *
	April 2019	Reinstatement	7am to 5pm Monday to Friday 7am to 2pm Saturday
Stage 3	Late-2019	Installation of above-ground infrastructure including an electrical equipment building and a bore pump	We will provide more information about this stage of work closer to the date

How will this work impact me?

Drilling the bore (late March to April 2019) will be noisy which is why we are limiting work between 7am and 10pm. We have undertaken some preliminary noise monitoring in the area to give us baseline noise levels and we will continue to monitor noise levels throughout the work.

We will also use noise blankets, sea containers and straw bales to minimise noise as much as possible.

You may also notice an increase in activity around the area. A temporary track will be constructed to help with access to the work area. Traffic management will be in place to ensure pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles can move around safely. You may also notice that we will be affecting a section of the reserve. We will be fully reinstating the affected area after completion of the drilling works to the City of Stirling's specification.

Where is this work happening?

The bore will be on the northern side of Sheldrake Reserve in Stirling and will involve the carpark off Sheldrake Street being closed during the construction period. Access to the cricket nets will not be affected.
