## Temporary closure – footpath (Donnelly Park to rear of Drovers Complex, Wanneroo) – May 2019



Water Corporation is building a pipeline from its Beenyup facility in Craigie to newly built bores in Wanneroo and Neerabup. Part of the 13km long pipeline extends along the eastern side of Lake Joondalup, along Scenic Drive and to the rear of the Drovers complex (cnr Joondalup Dr and Wanneroo Rd).

To safely install the pipeline, access to the footpath that runs from the western boundary of the Drovers complex, to the rear of the complex and through bushland and pine plantation to Donnelly Park will be closed. The nearby Wanneroo Road path (as shown in map to right) will provide access during the detours. Access to the Drovers complex will not be affected by this work.

Detour signage will be in place. The path is expected to reopen in July 2019. We thank the community for their patience and apologise for any inconvenience.

## Why is this work taking place?

As Perth continues to experience the impacts of climate change, the decision was made in July 2016 to expand our Groundwater Replenishment Scheme. This will provide better certainty for Perth's water supplies, seeing the Scheme's capacity increase from 14 billion litres per year to 28 billion litres a

year. The recharge pipeline is an essential part of the Groundwater Replenishment Scheme expansion.
